We, the faculty of physiotherapy, have organised a two day Workshop on Facilitating Motor Control Using Principles of Neurodevelopmental Therapy

Neurodevelopmental Therapy is an advanced hands-on approach to the examination and treatment of individuals with disturbances of function, movement and postural control due to a lesion of the central nervous system(CNS).

Neurodevelopmental therapy emphasis on decreasing muscle tone through the use of reflex inhibiting postures. Incorporation of hierarchical motor sequences into therapy, with one activity following another during facilitation (head control, rolling, sitting, quadruped, kneeling). Facilitation of automatic movement sequences as opposed to isolated developmental skills

Currently, it is recognized that there is a need to direct the treatment towards specific functional situations. Neurodevelopmental therapy focus to identify the patient's abilities and limitations in order to tailor an individualized treatment plan and provide a basis for comparing the client's abilities at a later point in time.

Dr.Saravanan Sivanithi is a practising physiotherapist and a neurodevelopmental therapist in Chennai, who shared his light of knowledge on the concept of working hypothesis of neurodevelopmental therapy and the base for analysing motor control to our students.

Since then it has been declared by UN globally that 21st June of every year would be “*International Yoga Day*”.

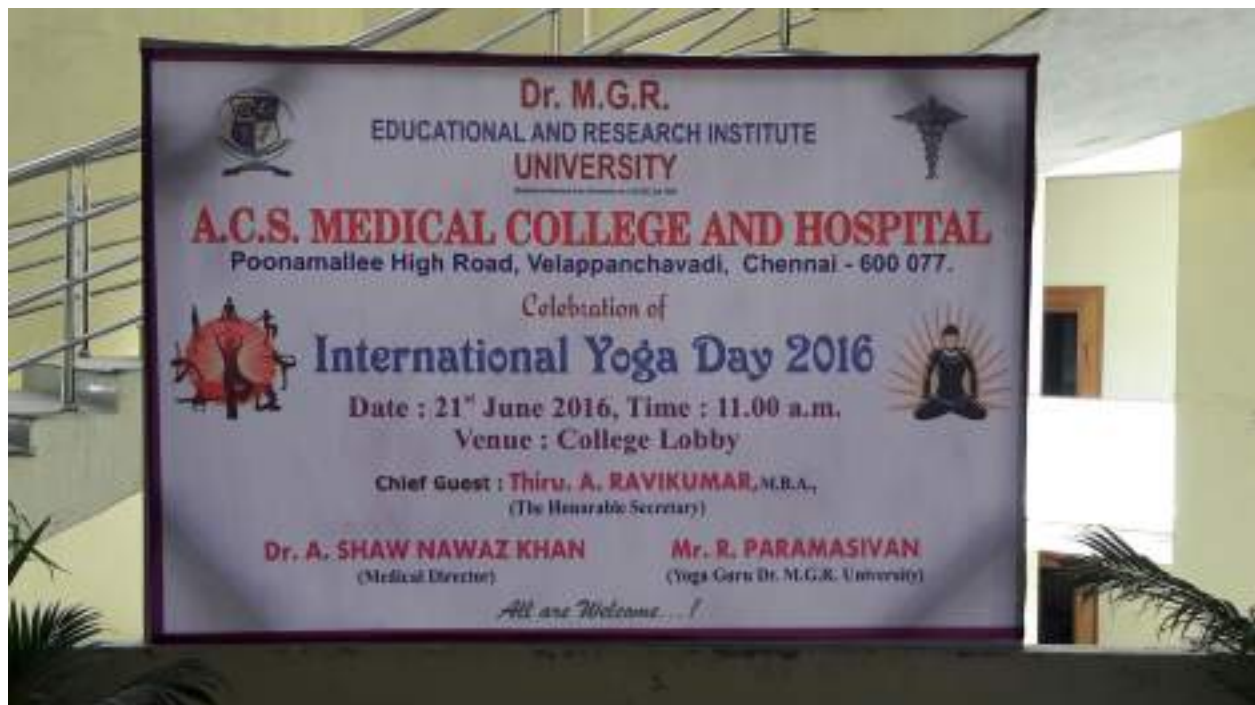
Keeping this as theme, a guest lecture & demonstration was arranged at our ACS. Medical college & Hospital campus.

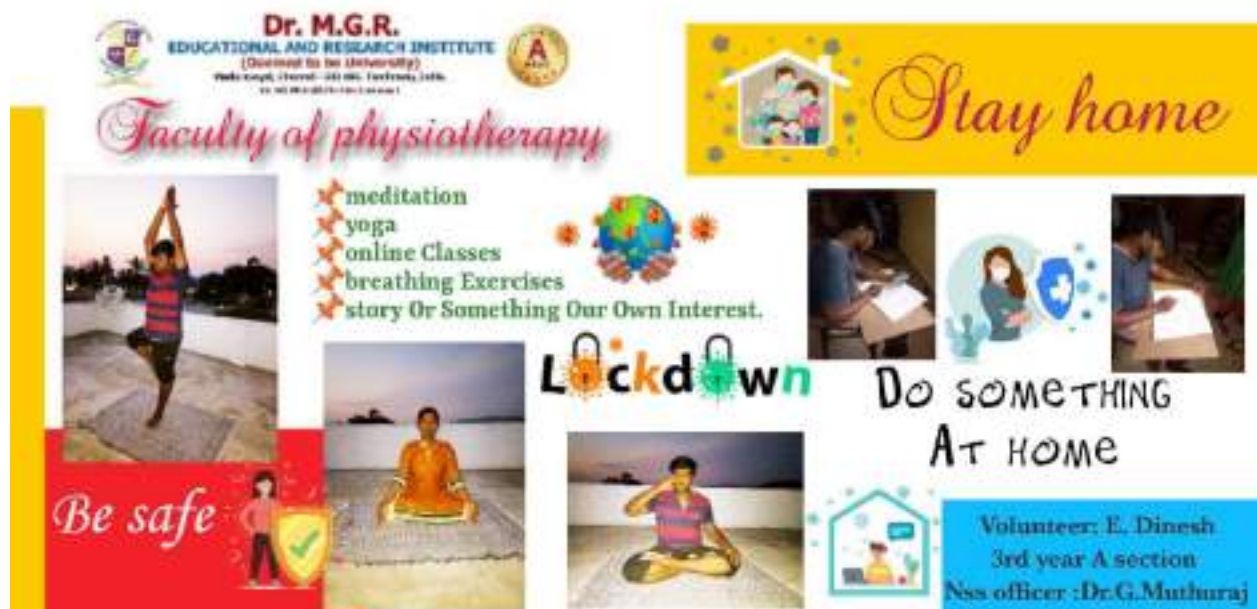

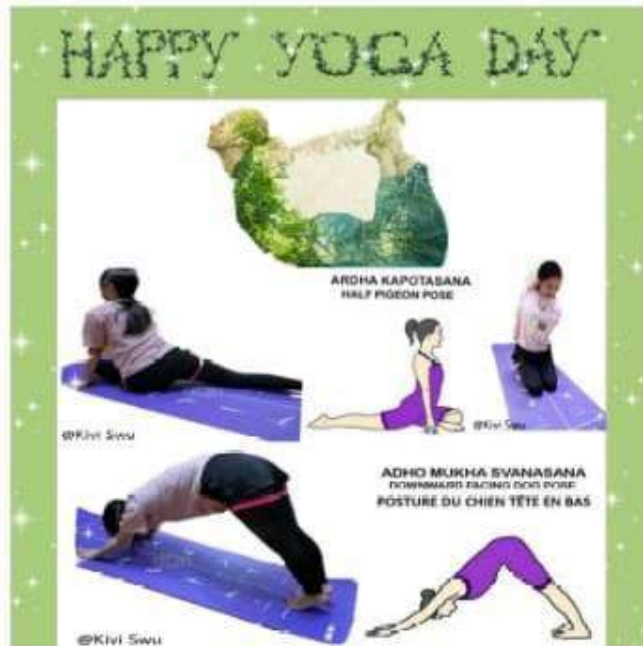
