

The Board of Studies meeting was held on 10.09.2019 at Dean's Chamber, ACS Medical College and Hospital, Chennai by 11.00 A.M. The Pro Vice Chancellor welcomed the members and briefed on the agenda of the meeting.

After detailed discussion the following resolution passed in the meeting;

- Implementation of New Curriculum (CBME) as per the new GMER guidelines was discussed and approved.
- According to the CBME, the syllabus was discussed in detail under the new regulation of the Board of Governors (suppression of MCI) and the same was accepted by all the members
- 3. The Aim, Goal, Objectives, Skills, Integration, Attitude and Communication were finalized.

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- 4. The competencies for theory, practical, small group teachings, self directed learning, integration and tutorials were demarcated along with the teaching learning methods and the number of hours.
- Topics to be covered in Paper I and Paper II for each subject was finalized.
- 6. Topics was separated as Core and Noncore as per NMC guidelines
- Regular periodic examinations shall be conducted throughout the course. There
 shall be no less than three internal assessment examination in each preclinical
 subjects.
 - a. The average of the theory internal assessment marks will be calculated for 40 marks to which 10 marks for continuous formative assessment will be added giving a total of 50.
 - b. The average of the practical examination will calculated for 40 marks to which 5 marks for Skill certification and 5 marks for record will be added giving a total of 50
- 8. Learners must secure atleast 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical, not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject.
- Learners must have completed the required certifiable competencies for phase I
 and completed the log book. Log book to be designed incorporating the certifiable
 skills.

10. University Examination

a. The first professional examination shall be held at the end of first professional training (12 + 1 months) in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry.

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b. Marks distribution

There shall be two theory papers of 100 marks each and the duration of each paper will be of three hours.

b. Eligibility criteria to appear for University examination

- i. Attendance 75% in theory and 80% in practicals
- ii. Internal assessment Learners must secure atleast 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical, not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject.

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c. Pass criteria for University examination

Learner must secure at least 40% marks in each of the papers with minimum 50% of the marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass in the said subject.

d. Internal assessment marks are not to be added to marks of the University examinations and should be shown separately in the grade card.


