Minutes of Board of studies for Super speciality subject -MCh-Urology

Minutes of meeting with regard to Board of studies for Super speciality course MCh-Urology was conducted online on 8-4-2021 at 10AM under the new regulations of the National medical commission.

The Board of studies meeting for Super speciality course MCh- Urology was attended by Internal member of Board of studies of Rajarajeswari medical college & hospital, Bengaluru coming under the ambit of Dr.MGR educational and research institute, Deemed to be university, Chennai and external member of Board of studies of MCh-Urology on 8-4-2021 at 10AM through online Google meet.

Resolutions passed :


Syllabus was discussed in detail by all the members and it was accepted by all

1. Final university theory examination shall consist of four papers of 100 marks each. Each paper in turn shall consist of 10 questions each carrying 10 marks.All questions shall be compulsory.
2. Final university clinical examination shall carry a total of 200 marks (75 marks for the Long case , 25 marks for each of the 3 Short cases & 2cases for ward rounds each carrying 25 marks.
3. Final university viva voce shall carry a total of 100marks (25marks for Operative surgery & instruments, 25 marks for Radiology, 25marks for Surgical pathology, 25marks for Research methodology / Recent advances).
4. A candidate shall secure not less than 50% marks in each head of passing which shall include (1) Theory, Obtaining a minimum of 40% marks in each theory paper and not less than 50% cumulatively in all the four papers. (2) Practical including clinical and viva voce examination. Obtaining of 50% marks in Practical examination shall be mandatory for passing the examination as a whole in the said examination as the case may be.
5. External examiner for the final university examination has to be from outside the state.

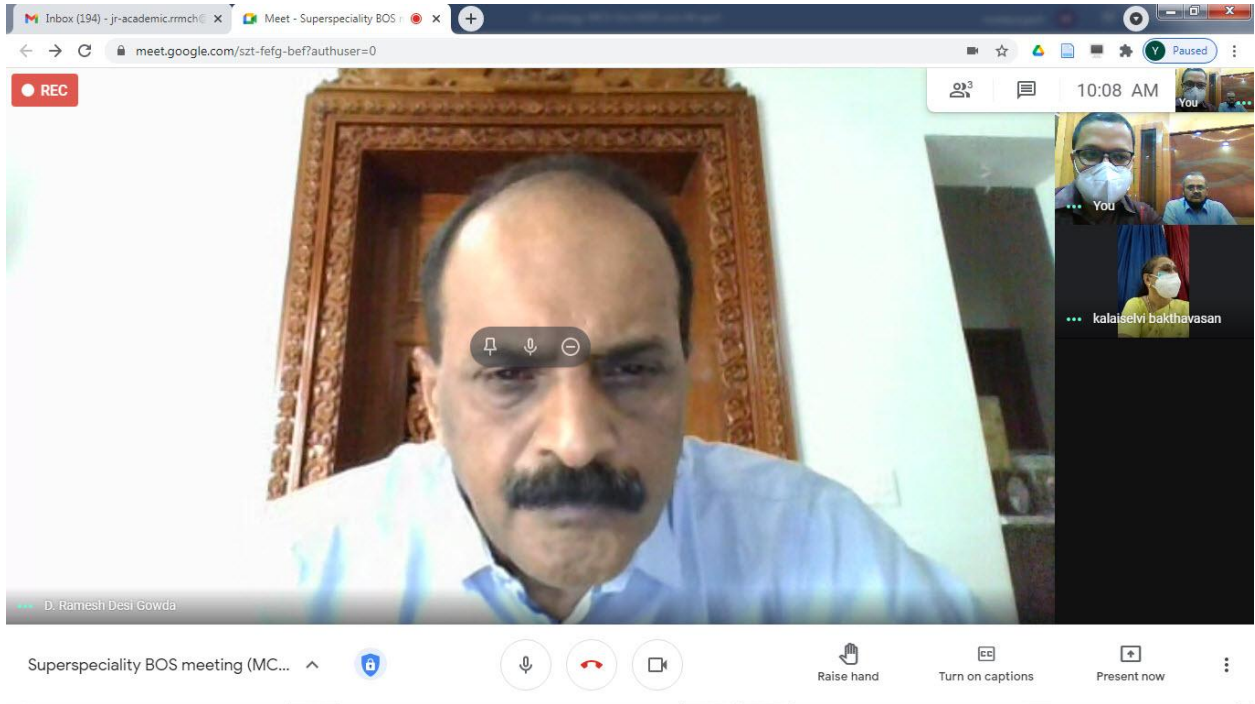

Resolutions passed :

Syllabus was discussed in detail by all the members and it was accepted by all

1. The student should attend one national and one state level conference in 3 years.
2. Each student must have one oral presentation and one oral/poster presentation in the state/national level conference.
3. Each student must have one original research publication and it is mandatory.
4. Journal club/seminar/clinical presentation will be conducted once a week and the student must take part in all these academic activities and must have presented 10times during the course of 3 years.
5. Periodic test theory will be conducted once a month.
6. Practical & Viva will be conducted once in two months.
7. External member suggested having a photo logbook.
8. Log books to be assessed on a monthly basis.
9. Rotation postings to be given for a duration of 4months in the following manner
 - a. Onco surgery - 1 month
 - b. Aesthetics - 1 month
 - c. cleft - 1 month

- d. Burns - 15 days
- e. Microtraining - 15 days

- 10. Final university exam will have 10 questions each carrying 10 marks in each paper. All questions are compulsory.
- 11. External member & internal member suggested a mock exam to be conducted at the end of 1st year and 2nd year (with one internal examiner & one external examiner). These marks can be taken for improvement marks in the final exam.
- 12. Final university practical exam will have 1 long case (100marks), 2 short cases (25 marks each) & 5 cases -ward rounds (10 marks each).
