### Day 1: 03.11.2021 - INAUGURATION



### Day 3: 15.11.2021







### Day 4: 16.11.2021

- ➤ Google keep- that can be accessed for taking notes and setting reminders quickly.


The session was an eye opener for the software tools which can be implemented in teaching learning program. Few queries from the students were addressed by the resource person. The session came to an end with the gratitude note.






Day 5: 17.11.2021





### Day 6: 18.11.2021
