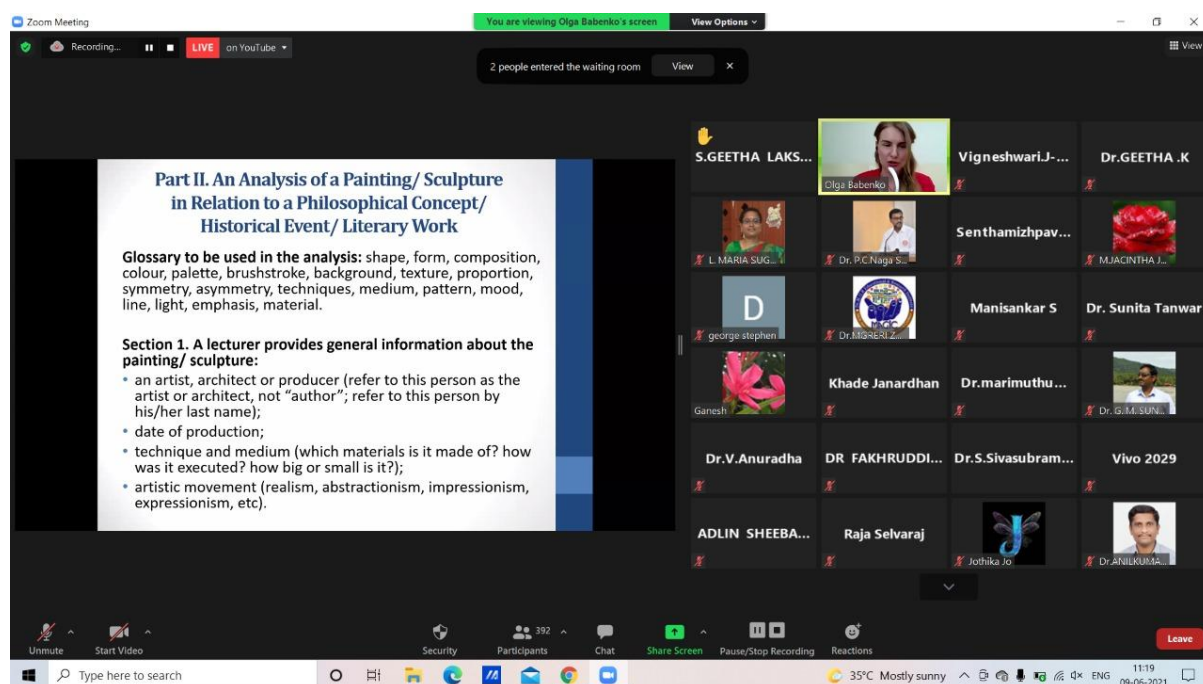


## Day 3



## Day 4



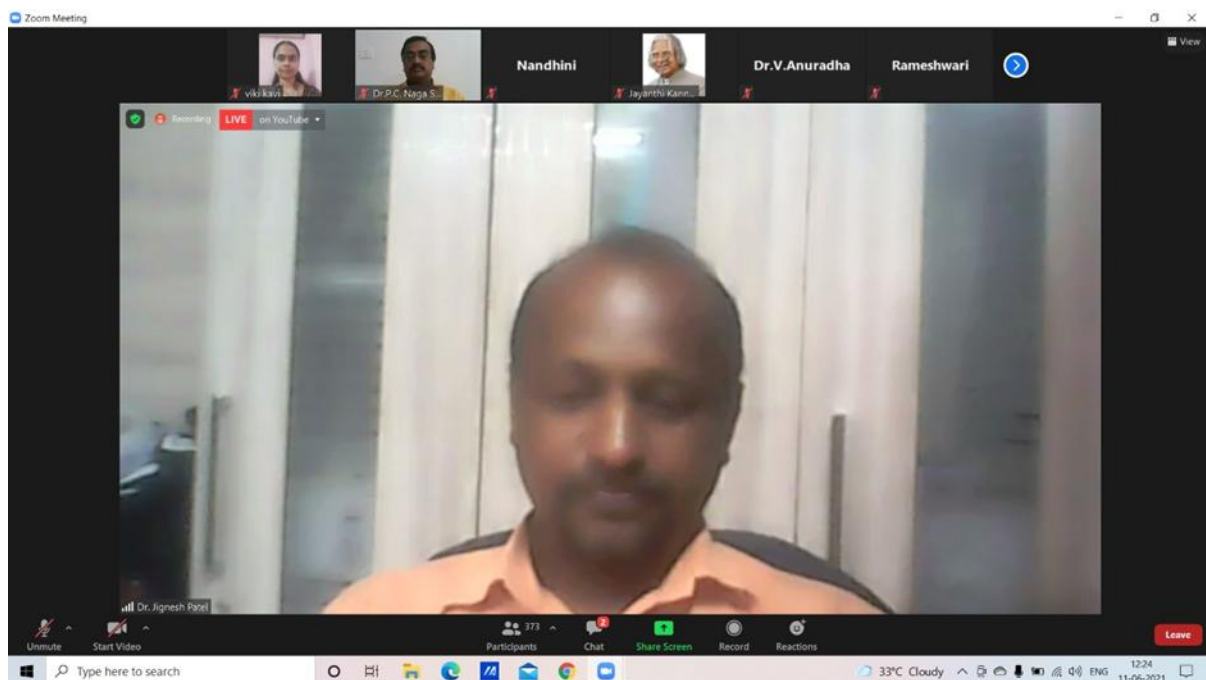

## Day 6

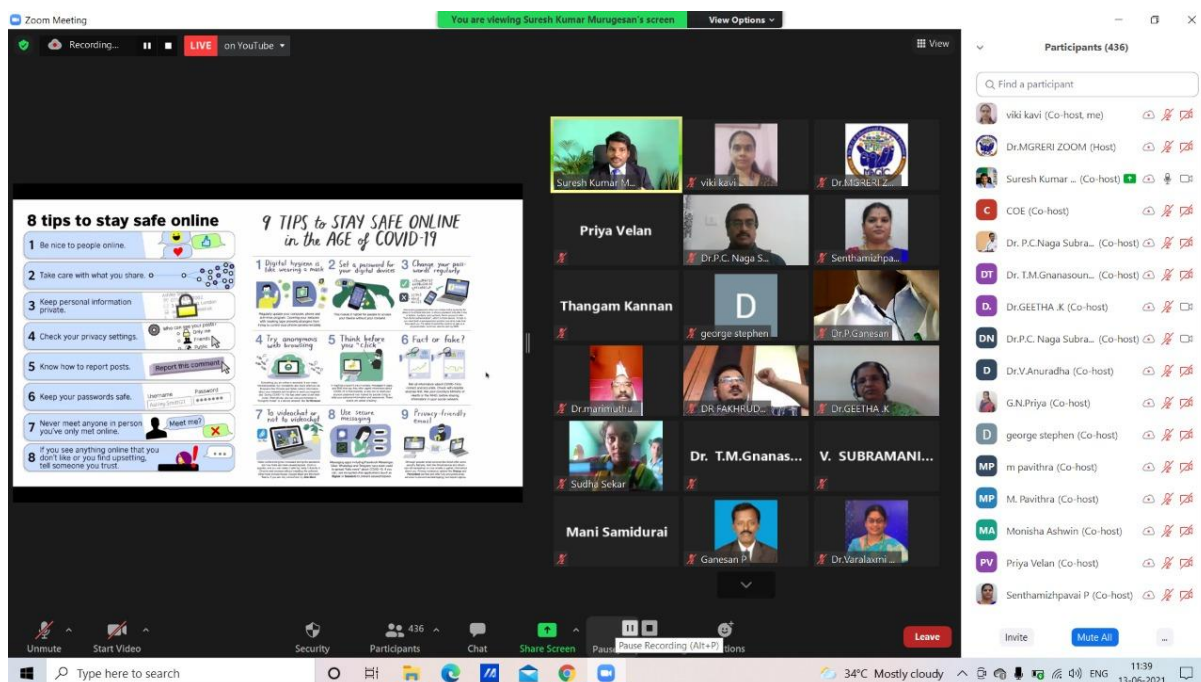
