

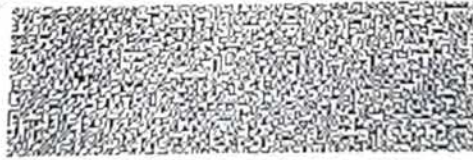

- b. To provide a formal basis for initiating interaction between the Parties

## 2. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

The budding engineers from the PARTY OF THE SECOND PART could play a key role in technological up gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge

Both Parties propose to collaborate through

- a. **Skill Development Programs:** UTL to train the students of **DR. MGRERI** on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready
- b. **Guest Lectures:** UTL to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of **Dr. MGRERI** on the technology trends
- c. **Faculty Development Programs:** UTL to train the Faculties of the **Dr. MGRERI**
- d. **Others:** Industrial visits to students and faculties at our Bangalore facilities, collaborative Research and Consulting

The PARTY OF THE FIRST PART has to develop Content and Deliver the proposed Skill Development / Value Added Training Courses either through Instructor Lead Training (ILT) or Live Virtual Class (LVC) and manage all the expenses connected with the training delivery

The PARTY OF THE SECOND PART has to facilitate in creating awareness among the students about the Skill Development / Value Added Programs and extend necessary support to the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART for the smooth delivery of the training programs by providing the required infrastructure. The SECOND PARTY has to assign a Coordinator (Single Point of Contact) for interaction with the FIRST PARTY

Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by issuing separate work orders / LOI between the two parties and Financial Considerations can be decided at the time of issuing work orders.

### 3. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The principal technical areas of collaboration between the Parties will be

- a. Embedded systems Design
- b. Computer Networking
- c. Telecommunications
- d. VLSI Design
- e. Any other relevant technologies mutually agreed upon by both Parties

The course details are enclosed herewith in the Annexure of this MOU.

### 4. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:
  - Is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
  - Is already known or become known to the receiving party
  - Is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
  - Is independently developed by the receiving party; or
  - Is required to be disclosed by law or court order

## 5. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MoU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire 3 years after the effective date. This MoU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MoU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MoU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under this agreement for the ongoing programs. Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 4 above, or any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MoU, which obligations shall survive any such termination.

## 6. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

## 7. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein that this MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

## 8. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity.
