


Exploiting Marine Bacteria for Production of Value-added Biomaterials from Renewable Resources: An Effort towards Embracing Circular Economy'

Tech. & Faculty of Education in collaboration with Office of International Relations organized an International Webinar on 'Exploiting Marine Bacteria for Production of Value-added Biomaterials from Renewable Resources: An Effort towards Embracing Circular Economy' on 23.03.2021 The Resource person Ts.Dr.Kesaven Bhubalan, Associate Professor, Head of Marine Science & Acting Deputy Dean of Talent and Research at the Faculty of Science and Marine Environment, Universiti Malaysia Terengganu (UMT) explained the need of the hour in protecting the Marine Bacteria from getting exploited and to produce Biomaterials from the renewable resources and to increase the economy. Marine microorganisms are unique to tolerate high salt concentration and can evade toxicity of different metal ions. However, these marine microbes are not sufficiently explored for their capability of metal nanoparticle synthesis. Although, marine water is one of the richest sources of gold in the nature, however, there is no significant publication regarding utilization of marine microorganisms to produce gold nanoparticles. Therefore, there might be a possibility of exploring marine bacteria as nanofactories for AuNP biosynthesis.
