GREEN SYNTHESIS OF SILVER NANOPARTICLES USING PLANT EXTRACTS AS REDUCING AGENTS

Over the past few decades, metal nanoparticles less than 100 nm in diameter have made a substantial impact across diverse biomedical applications, such as diagnostic and medical devices, for personalized healthcare practice. In particular, silver nanoparticles (AgNPs) have great potential in a broad range of applications as antimicrobial agents, biomedical device coatings, drug-delivery carriers, imaging probes, and diagnostic and optoelectronic platforms, since they have discrete physical and optical properties and biochemical functionality tailored by diverse size and shape - controlled AgNPs, We aimed to present major routes of synthesis of AgNPs, including physical, chemical synthesis processes, along with discrete physicochemical characteristics of AgNPs. Lastly, the students concluded this review with a summary of current applications of AgNPs in nanoscience and nanomedicine and discussed their future perspectives in these areas. Plant extracts are used as reducing and stabilizing agents in the preparation of silver nanoparticles (AgNPs). The leaves of N.cadamba were used to make the extracts. The size distribution was examined using two different techniques: UV-VI and a microscope. Silver nanoparticles are used widely in the biomedical industry thus we are using the plant extract to stabilize the nanoparticles to not get agglomerate and to extend the particles in the Nano size as much as possible.

This work explains the origin, uses and the profile of existence of Terminalia catappa as well as its potential ability as a corrosion inhibitor. This work is focused on to evaluate corrosion inhibitor using artificial seawater in the presence of Terminalia catappa extract (TCE). Terminalia catappa is a large tropical tree in the leadwood tree family, combretaceae, native to Asia, Australia, the Pacific and Madagascar. Common names in English include country almond, Indian almond, Malabar almond, sea almond, tropical almond, beach almond and false kamani. Terminalia catappa was collected from the local area of Kuala Terengganu, Malaysia. The sample was collected, cleaned, dried and ground to obtain its powder form. The mild steels were cut into 25 mm x 25 mm x 3 mm and polished using a polishing machine with different grades of sandpaper (240, 600, 800 and 1000-grit). The polished steel was cleaned, dried and placed in a plastic packet in the presence of silica gel. Later, each sample was weighed using a weighing balance and stored in a dry box until used. The powder of T. catappa was macerated in 70% ethanol at a ratio of 1:10 for 3 days. Later, the mixture was filtered using a what man no. 1 filter paper and concentrated using a rotary evaporator. The obtained TCE was stored in a refrigerator at 4 °C until used.

Different test were carried on to study the active constituents in the extract and to measure the progress of corrosion rate of mild steels in the presence and absence of the inhibitor. The examination TCE under KBr-FTIR was conducted to identify the presence of functional groups. The EIS method is a common practice for corrosion inhibition studies. The potentiodynamic or Tafel polarization analysis measured the susceptibility of corrosion through the current–voltage (I–V) relation with respect to the properties of the medium. The morphological study on the immersed steels after 10 days of immersion in artificial seawater was performed using a Tescan Vega SEM at a magnification of x500. The leaves extract of Terminalia catappa successfully reduced the corrosion rate of mild steels and managed to preserve the integrity of the steel's surface even after 10 days of exposure period to artificial seawater.






The plant Acacia leucophloea is reported to have great medicinal value in Indian medicine. The present study deals with the pharmacognostical investigation on leaves of Acacia Leucophloea. Plant extracts are used for checking the cytotoxicity of HepG2 and LO2 cells. The leaves of A. leucophloea were used to make the extracts and checked the cytotoxicity of cells using MTT assay. The extraction of A. leucophloea leaves powder was weighed at 78.428 g by using a weighing machine and it was added to 1000 ml of methanol. And kept for 2-3 days in room temperature. The extract was filtered with Whatman No.1 paper and the extract was collected. The Rotavapor was done to remove all the methanol content from the extract and kept to dry completely. The culture was incubated for 1-2 days. It was observed every day. The HepG2 cells and LO2 cell culture underwent Sub culture for N number of times. When the cells reached above 80% the MTT assay was started. LO2 & HepG2 cells were seeded in 96 well plates. The samples (S1, S2, S3, S4) were treated in the plates and kept for incubation for 24hrs. After 24hrs, MTT solution is added and cells incubated at 37°C for 3hrs. Medium wad replaced with DMSO. Then the plates were observed checked using Microplate reader. At 100conc. the samples are more effective in killing the HepG2 cells. And also compare to all samples VS is more effective in killing the HepG2 cells in all the concentrations. For LO2 cells, given samples are not that much effective in killing the cells. And also compare to all samples VS is slightly effective in killing the LO2 cells.



IEEE Singapore AUV Challenge 2022

To design and development of an Autonomous Underwater Vehicle (AUV). AUVs are robotic submarines that are a part of the emerging field of autonomous and unmanned vehicles. This project shows the design implementation of an AUV as a miniature size and its test bed platform for a variety of research in underwater technologies especially involving smallscale, surface water, and low-cost underwater robots. The general design and its consideration are well discussed in this paper. The AUV prototype has been developed by Solid Works. It will have a fixed mechanical system and body, having a modular electronic system that allows the development of various controllers. The controller and motors have been tested in small-scale surface water and the result is encouraging. Some factors affecting AUV performance are also elaborated for future research in this area. Underwater robots can explore areas of the ocean that are too dangerous or too difficult for humans to go. The use of underwater robots is helpful to explore and study the ecosystems in the oceans and seas all over the world, 75% of the earth is discovered with water. Humans are unable to work underwater at depths more than a few meters for a long duration and to acquire the data which helps in mining or surveys. Underwater robots can easily take over this task and are most useful here. It is very difficult and expensive to design and develop a system for humans, which can sustain the conditions and challenges encountered in deep sea underwater exploration.







On this occasion, the French cultural-educational network in India bought over 100 presentations across 19 Indian cities.


