- Future directions in deep learning research, including the development of more robust and interpretable models (Pure York) (York CS).

#### Conclusion

The seminar provided valuable insights into the current state and future potential of deep learning. Dr. Appiah's expertise and comprehensive coverage of the topic left the attendees with a deeper understanding of the subject and its far-reaching implications.






