



It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution to ensure, in such circumstances, that the research is completed with the co-investigator of the research project.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator to ensure that research work is completed within the stipulated time. In the event of failure to comply, the institution and Principal Investigator are jointly liable to refund the research amount released by the University.


