1	Dr. Rama Vaidyanathan gave a brief note on the Atal Ranking of Institutes on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) ranking parameters and how the Institute has presently a ranking in Band A (Rank 6 – 25) among Deemed Universities. The advantages of getting a better rank in such accreditation helps in allowing us to apply for grant schemes. Case in point, we are eligible to apply for STARS-MHRD grant only because of our NAAC ranking. The objective of the meet was to make a strategic plan to go higher up in the ARIIA ranking. The 2 most important parameters for ARIIA raking are start-ups incubated in the Institute and Commercialization of technology. 

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
