



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


Figure 1: Indian Council of Medical Education (ICME)

4. **Aim of the Project:**

The main aim of this project is to carry out a feasibility study for indigenous CRDI technology for the CRDI system of high-power heavy-duty diesel engines for Armoured fighting vehicles. 
