

Syllabus for Written Test: CET- IE 2020

The syllabus of Common Entrance Test (CET) for PGDM/MBA in **Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development (IEV)** 2020 has been divided into five sections, i.e.

- (1) Quantitative Aptitude/Business Mathematics,
- (2) Awareness of Business/Start-up Affairs,
- (3) Logical Reasoning & Data Interpretation,
- (4) Reading Comprehension &
- (5) Psychometric Assessment.

The detailed syllabuses for these sections are given below:

Quantitative Aptitude/Business Mathematics

Business Mathematics will consist of Mathematical concepts related to business. Logical Reasoning and Data Interpretation

Logical reasoning will include questions that are intended to judge analytical, rational, and perceptive skills of the candidate. The reasoning questions will check the ability to extract and work with the meaning, information, and implications from the given text and the images or diagrams. The data interpretation section will include assigning meaning to business data, construe ideas from the available data, and take relevant decisions.

Reading Comprehension

It measures the candidates' skill to process text, draw inferences, understand logical relationships between significant points, understand words and statements, and follow the development of concepts. Also, the candidates will be tested on the following reading skills: inference, main idea, supporting the idea, logical structure, and style.

Psychometric Assessment

Psychometric assessment will help to assess the intention of innovation and entrepreneurial qualities of aspirants. This Test will include the measurement of entrepreneurial skill, creativity, Innovation, and other relevant entrepreneurial traits and behaviours.
