About Dr. MGR NewGen IEDC

Dr. MGR Educational and Research Institute is happy to announce the 2nd Round of Call for Project under the Dr. MGR NewGen IEDC fund. This is a prestigious grant from NSTEDB, Dept of Science and Technology, Govt. of India at the Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Center of Excellence in Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Adayalampattu West Campus. A student start-up Center has been established under this grant. The Center has equipment and facilities for prototyping and testing student projects. The Center has mentors who are involved in Industry oriented research.

In the first round of Call for Ideas, 10 projects from students of Dr. MGR Educational and Research Institute were funded. The Center is working on commercialization of these projects now.

Scope of the Call

Ideas or early stage technology based start-ups that require mentoring for preparing a Business Plan, initial experimentation and building a prototype will be chosen for funding under this call. At the end of the pre-incubation, the incubatee will have a Business Plan and can make an elevator pitch to prospective investors. Grant upto Rs. 2,00,000/- can be used towards creating the prototype and for cost of testing, marketing, patenting etc. Further students can apply to Startup Nidhi which will give a funding of Rs. 10 lakhs.

Student groups who have identified a company which is ready to mentor or fund the project will have an advantage in the selection.

Expectation

It is expected that the shortlisted student groups use the funding for the following:

- Developing their proof of concept prototype from their idea
- Test if there is a market for the product
- Link with experts in the field and to make their plan to prospective investors and collaborators.
- Students must report to Dr. MGR NewGenIEDC for a total 12 hours per week for 2 Semesters to carry out their work.
- They will be required to get trained in business skills as prescribed by the Center
- The students must represent the University to participate in hackathons and other competitions

Not within the scope of the Call

The grant can not be used for conducting basic research or for testing non-commercializable projects. It can also not be given to projects which have been funded in the earlier round of IEDC or from other such funding sources.

Eligibilty

Primary Applicant of the NewGenIEDC must be Science and Technology students or alumni of Dr. MGR Educational and Research Institute.

Mentors

Mentors will be appointed by DrMGR NewGEnIEDC from faculty or external experts. It is mandatory for faculty mentors to report to Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Center atleast 2 days a week for the mentoring.

Submission Process

Students teams must submit their project ideas in the attached format and submit to <u>director-rd@drmgrdu.ac.in</u> on or before 29th Nov 2018.

Evaluation

The projects will be evaluated by a group of resource persons from Industry and Academia based on

- (1) novelty and Innovation of their idea
- (2) Approach, Methodology, feasibility
- (3) Commercialization potential / Target market
- (4) Sustainability and adaptability
- (5) Student commitment and capability

Allowable Costs

Capital Costs	:Equipment and Accessories relevant to the project activities. It must b			
	located at Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Center of Excellence.			
Recurring Costs	:Consumables, travel and outsourcing of some aspects. This cannot be more			
	that 30 % of the total grant			
Student Fellowship	:The student group will be given a fellowship upon completion of each			
	target mutually agreed upon.			
Mentoring Fee	:Mentors who contribute technically to the project will be paid a mentoring			
	fee.			

Budget of each project will be approved on a case to case basis by the Technical Advisory Group.
