#### MINUTES OF THE MEETING

- 1. The Director –IQAC, Dr.P.Udhayakala welcomed the following dignitaries and thanked them for their presence.
  - Dr.G.Gopalakrishnan, Provost Dr.M.G.R. Educational and Research Institute.
  - Dr.V.Cyril Raj, Joint Registrar, Dr.M.G.R. Educational and Research Institute.
  - Prof.S.Kannan, External expert from L.N.Govt. College, Ponneri. He is a participant in various state council funded projects of Tamil Nadu Government for development of science in rural areas and resource person for creating e-learning material for Tamil Nadu state board higher secondary classes.
  - Mr.Prabakaran, Alumni of IIT Kanpur, Ex- production manager of Salem steel plant, DGM-Jindal steel, USA, MD of JPsolars.
  - HoDs of various Department, IQAC-Co-ordinators, parent and student representatives.

The director congratulated the following outstanding achievers of our University.

- Dr.Felix kala, Dean (Student affairs) for receiving **Research Ratnaaward** from RULA.
- Dr.s.Geetha, HoD of CSE for receiving **Best woman Engineer 2019award** by the Institution of Engineers.
- Kudos to the office of International Relations for their excellent work in international student & staff exchangeprogrammes.
- 2. The provost Dr.G.Gopala Krishnan emphasized the crucial role played by IQAC in rising above mediocrity to achieve excellence. He said that this can be achieved only if quality consciousness pervades all tasks executed by all faculty members without exception. He opined that short comings must be identified and accepted first in turn would lead the way to surmount the obstacles and meet 2021NAAC.
- 3. Dr.V.CyrilRaj,Joint Registrar (Academics)appreciated the Departments that have adopted the practice of encouraging students who have done certification courses through NPTEL,MOOC & Swayam by awarding eligible credits. He said that HoDs evaluate the students in these courses after familiarizing with the relevant open source content. He strongly felt that technology based teaching and chalk- talk should be used in tandem to improve the learningprocess.
- 4. In order to give impetus to inter disciplinary projects, he proposed that highest grades should be given and atleast 2 projects per Department should necessarily be inter disciplinary innature.
- 5. Dr.V.Ganesan, HoD, Mech countered that highest grades should not be denied for a project in the core discipline. He also opened up suggestions regarding Interdisciplinary research for researchscholars.
- 6. The Director IQAC concurred with the Joint Registrar (Academic) and felt that

- interdisciplinary research was more beneficial to the society and hence should be awarded better grades.
- 7. The provost suggested the students should not be forced to take a project. It must be left to their interest.
- 8. Dr.N.Jayachithra, HoD, Chemical Eng. Dept. informed that students were not compelled and she explained the method of allotting the projects in her Department and also suggested if a student has to do inter disciplinary project he/she should know the resources available in other Department or other Faculty.
- 9. Dr.Sridevi, IQAC ( i/c) read the reports of the Departmental IQAC meetingfor Medical, Dental, Physiotherapy, Pharmacy, Nursing andH&S.
- 10. Dr.Kanya, IQAC (i/c) read the reports of the Departmental IQAC meetingfor E&T, Architecture, Hotel Management and De novocourses.
- 11. The external Expefert, Prof.S.Kannan highlighted that ICT should be understood clearly by the policy makers. He informed ICT can only make the student understand the underlying concept and in no way it can replace a teacher and the chalk and talk teaching methodology. The student should attend the class and interact with the teacher when an ICT is used in the classroom. And he also added that the faculty members should be given proper training to create a material and they should be very clear about the purpose while creating like whether it is for demonstration, evaluation, teaching or learning. He alsoplayed a short video created by him for the Tamil Nadu State Board Higher secondary class.
- 12. The External Expert Mr.Prabakaran, pin pointed the necessity for renewable energy for sustainable development. He felt that there is enormous scope for interdisciplinary skills in carrying forward social agenda.
- 13. Ms.Anuradha, as a parent expressed that although technology is advantageous, in the hands of children, she felt it is more used for entertainment than for educational purposes.
- 14. Ms.MaryJullie,student of M.Sc Chemistry shared her joyful experienceof learning through Google classroom.
- 15. Mr.Rokesh&Mr.Bala, students of B.Tech Chemical Engineering shared their positive experience in doing their interdisciplinary project with the Bio technology Department and they thanked both the Department Heads and their project guide Ms.Tanmayee for hersupport.
- 16. Dr.Johnson, HoD, Maths Dept, who also heads the digital learning monitoring cell concurs with the views of Prof.Kannan. He requested the Department Heads to complete the econtent creation planned according to the schedule and thanked IQAC for including Digital learning in the Agenda.
- 17. Dr.N.S.Shubhashree, Dean E & Sinformedthat I year E & T provides study materials



through an exclusive website www.drmgriyearbtech .com and also use Google class room as ICT for teaching & learning .She also highlighted that I Year B.tech students under the subject "Orientation to Entrepreneurship & projectLab" do projects under various fields of engineering technologies and around 55student projects have been show cased during the project Expo2019.
